

**Synopsis of the Cooperation Arrangement between  
the Government of the HKSAR and  
the Government of the Republic of Peru  
on Trade and Investment Facilitation**

(prepared by the Intellectual Property Department)

The Government of the HKSAR and the Government of the Republic of Peru (collectively referred to as the Participants) have signed a cooperation arrangement in November 2008. The fields of cooperation between the Participants under the arrangement include, among others, the protection of intellectual property rights (IPR).

The Participants will endeavour to strengthen exchanges and cooperation on the automation of intellectual property (IP) registration services and intellectual capital management. The Participants will also share experiences and provide mutual support in public awareness relating to promoting respect for and acquisition of IPR. They will build capacity on IPR enforcement and encourage technology transfer through licensing arrangement. There will also be exchanges of information on the formulation and implementation of laws and regulations in respect of IP protection, on IPR registration and other aspects of IP.
